

Dr. Peter Au Yeung explained in details the process of assessing by doctors of any reported miracles. All the medical history and laboratory reports (histology, X-Rays and CAT scans) must first be assessed by a board of doctors. It is then referred to the International Lourdes Medical Committee which investigates every detail. When this is completed, it is referred to the Church authorities for assessment. A medically inexplicable cure must have the original diagnosis confirmed. The cure must be immediate and complete before it is declared a miracle.

Actual cases discussed include the cases of

- a) Sister Bernadette Moriau (in 2017)
- b) John Traynor (WWI soldier with neck injury)
- c) Alexis Carrel (1912 Nobel Laureate of Medicine)
- d) Victoria Micheli ((malignant sarcoma of hip bone)
